



Cyrus One

Producer: La Tour Melas

Vintage: 2020

The wine has intense blueberry and raspberry aromas, and notes of blackcurrant buds. It is perfectly combined with spices of wood (vanilla, toasted aromas). Smooth, with a medium body structure. Cyrus One has grapes from two different terroirs yet blended harmoniously. The Agiorgitiko variety comes from the soils of ancient Nemea whiles as the Merlot and Cabernet Franc come from Achinos in Central Greece bordered by the sea. Separate vinification of each variety with spontaneous fermentation-Malolactic fermentation in condition for the Cabernet Fanc/Merlot.
