



## Romeiko

**Producer: Manousakis Winery** 

Vintage: 2021

Notes: Romeiko is indigenous to Crete and is a light redskinned grape. After a Blanc de Noir vinification takes place we are left with a bright lemon-green color wine. The wine produced from this grape has is a medium body, with a fresh, citrus flavor. Unripe gooseberry, grassy notes, and some marzipan. Medium bodies and fresh mouth with intense flavor of white stone fruit.
