



# Romeiko

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**Producer:** Manousakis Winery

**Vintage:** 2021

**Tasting Notes:** Romeiko is indigenous to Crete and is a light red-skinned grape. After a Blanc de Noir vinification takes place we are left with a bright lemon-green color wine. The wine produced from this grape has a medium body, with a fresh, citrus flavor. Unripe gooseberry, grassy notes, and some marzipan. Medium bodies and fresh mouth with intense flavor of white stone fruit.

**Farming:** Organic, handpicked, vegan.

**Soils:** Deep, clay loamy, calcareous soil 550 to 600 meters
